

**Nemo Vista Middle School**  
**Public Meeting 2018-2019**  
**October 11, 2018**

Nemo Vista Middle School meets standards set by the Arkansas Department of Education. Nemo Vista Middle School has received a Public School Rating of an "A". 2018 ESSA School Report indicates that 67.8% of the 6-8 students are achieving in Literacy, which is down 10.61% from 2017. The report also indicates that 65.5% of the 6-8 students are achieving in Math, which is down 3.82% from 2017.

**Mission Statement: Every Child Every Chance**

**Enrollment: Nemo Vista Middle School has 86 students.  
The student body is down 9 students from the year before.**

**1. Comprehensive Assessment**

- A. Renaissance Learning---A computerized assessment to assess early literacy skill, math skills and literacy skills in grades K-12.**
- B. iReady—A computerized assessment and intervention in literacy and math in grades K-8.**
- C. ACT Aspire---The ACT Aspire College and Career Readiness Solution a vertically-scaled assessment suite connected to The ACT®. This assessment will be given to grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> in Literacy, Math, and Science.**

**2. Nemo Vista Middle School 2018-2019 School Improvement Plan will address the following:**

- A. Economically Disadvantaged Reading Level Scores will increase 5% from the 2017 SQSS to the 2018 SQSS.**
- B. Student Engagement Scores on the SQSS will increase 5% from 2017 to 2018.**
- C. Value-added growth scores will improve 5% from the 2017 ESSA School Index to the 2018 ESSA School Index.**

3. **Retention:** Nemo Vista has a retention rate of 0% in grades 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>..
4. **Transferring from an unsafe environment:** Nemo Vista Elementary has a transferring rate of 0%.
5. **Transferring in pursuant of School Choice:** Nemo Vista Elementary has transferred rate of 1%.

**Goals for 2018-2019 School Year:**

- 1) **To address the weak areas of our curriculum based on ACT Aspire results from the 2017-2018 school year.**
- 2) **To have an action plan for children who are considered at-risk.**
- 3) **To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.**
- 4) **To actively involve parents in their children's education.**
- 5) **To actively involve eighth grade in career and college readiness program.**
- 6) **To have Student Success Plans for all students in grades 6-8.**
- 7) **Continue to align 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade pacing guides to the Arkansas State Standards.**
