Unit 1 ***Sentences***. We will cover parts of a sentence, beginning and ending sentences, statements, questions, exclamations, and commands.

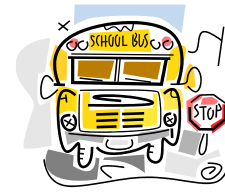


Social Studies
