wiggled – to move from side to side

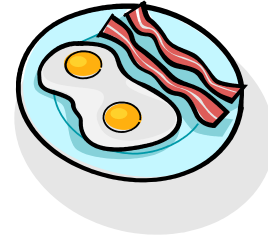
promised – to say you will definitely do something



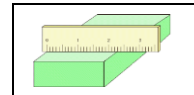

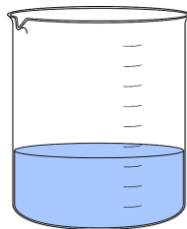
### English
