**Mission Statement: Every Child Every Chance**

## **ESSA Report:**

- Nemo Vista Middle School meets standards set by the Arkansas Department of Education. Nemo Vista Middle School has received a Public School Rating of an “A”.
- Literacy Scores: 60.72% of the students are achieving, which is down 5.21% from 2017. However, our students outscored the state of Arkansas by 13.47%.
- Math Scores: 65.17% of the students are achieving, which is a 1.15% increase from 2017. Our students outscored the state by 15.81%.

## **Enrollment:**

- Nemo Vista Middle School has 101 students (Not included: 3 Home school students 1 student comes 1 period a day/other 2 come 2 periods a day).
- The student body has grown 15 students from the year before.
- 1 freedom of choice into the district

## **Comprehensive Assessment**

- Renaissance Learning---A computerized assessment to assess early literacy skill, math skills, and literacy skills in grades K-12.
- iReady—A computerized assessment and intervention in literacy and math in grades K-8.
- ACT Aspire---The ACT Aspire College and Career Readiness Solution a vertically-scaled assessment suite connected to The ACT®. This assessment will be given to grades 3rd-10th in Literacy, Math, and Science.

## **School Improvement Plan:**

- **Long Term Goal:** On the 2019 SQSS: Reading at Grade Level Score will increase by 5% compared to the 2018 SQSS: Reading at Grade level Score.  
**Short Term Goal:** On the 2018-2019 STAR, 60% of the students will increase their reading level each Semester.
- **Long Term Goal:** On the student survey: 60% of the students will feel no repercussions involving reporting bullying.  
**Short Term Goal:** 10% decrease of students’ discipline slips involving student to student involvement.
- **Long Term Goal:** On the students disciplinary slips: The overall number of student’s discipline slips will be reduced by 10%  
**Short Term Goal:** 10% decrease in students’ classroom disruption discipline slips.

**Goals for 2019-2020 School Year:**

- 1) To address the weak areas of our curriculum based on ACT Aspire results from the 2018-2019 school year.
- 2) To have an action plan for children who are considered at-risk.
- 3) To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.
- 4) To actively involve parents in their children's education.
- 5) To actively involve eighth grade in career and college readiness program.
- 6) To have Student Success Plans for all students in grades 6-8.
- 7) Continue to align 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade pacing guides to the Arkansas State Standards.

**Statements of Meeting Goals:**
