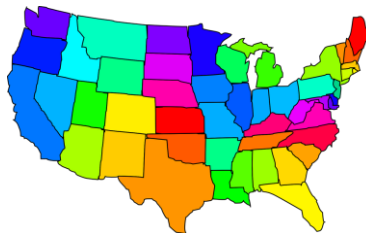
Handwriting
