

Annual Public Meeting
Thursday, October 10, 2019 at 6:30 pm

The Nemo Vista School District held its Annual Public Meeting on October 10, 2019 in conjunction with the regular October board meeting. Superintendent Logan Williams began the meeting by discussing the District/ School assessment scores. He congratulated the Principals and their staff for being ranked in the top 10%, in the State, on their ESSA rankings, and that the District is in a Level 1 Support category by ADE/DESE rankings. Mr. Williams stated that all vending machine monies received by the district go towards supporting athletics. Mr. Williams said the State requires all board members to receive six hours of professional development each year and new members to receive nine hours of professional development, and that all school board members had either met this requirement or were on track to complete the requirement by December 31st of this year.

Superintendent Williams discussed the building and grounds improvement projects that were completed within the past year, which include; concrete floor finish renovation in the lower Elementary Building. Mr. Williams also discussed projects the District is considering in the future, which include; a new hard court for the Elementary and Middle School playground areas, and shading and/ or protective coverings for the Baseball/Softball Complex.

Superintendent Williams then discussed the financial status of the district. He stated the District was in good financial standing at the present time, while also dealing with a decline in total assessments and the ongoing protest of property taxes owed by Southwestern Energy Company, Inc. (SWN) for two consecutive tax years. In regards to the District budget, all of these financial situations were considered, and are issues the District has planned for to the best of their ability.
