## Nemo Vista Elementary

Public Meeting 2020-2021 October 15, 2020

Nemo Vista Elementary meets standards set by the Arkansas Department of Education. Nemo Vista Elementary has received a Public School Rating of a "B". 2019 ESSA School Report indicates that 52.8 % of the 3-5 students are achieving in Literacy, which is down 15.7% from 2018. The report also indicates that 58.3% of the 3-5 students are achieving in Math, which is down 14.7% from 2018. Nemo Vista Elementary School did not test in the Spring of 2020 due to Covid-19, so at this time our data has not changed.

**Enrollment: 239 Students K-5 (Up 9 students from 2020)**

- 1. Comprehensive Assessment
  - A. Renaissance Learning---A computerized assessment to assess early literacy skill, math skills and literacy skills in grades K-5.
  - B. NWEA—A computerized assessment to track progress in literacy and math in grades K-5.
  - C. SuccessMaker---A computerized intervention in literacy and math in graded K-5
  - C. ACT Aspire---The ACT Aspire College and Career Readiness Solution a vertically-scaled assessment suite connected to The ACT®. This assessment will be given to grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> in Literacy, Math, and Science.
- 2. Nemo Vista Elementary 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan addressed the following:
  - A. Reading Levels on the SQSS will increase 5% from 2019 to 2020. The 2019 score was 58.33%. The ACT aspire was not given in the spring of 2020 due to Covid-19.

- B. Student Engagement Scores on the SQSS will increase 5% from 2019 to 2020. Unable to collect a full year absentee data due to school ending at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter in 2020.
- C. On the student survey: 65% of the students will feel no repercussions involving reporting bullying. Unable to collect a full year discipline slips data due to the school ending at the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter in 2020.
- 3. Nemo Vista Elementary 2020-2021 School Improvement Plan will address the Following:
  - A. Reading Levels on the SQSS will increase 5% from 2019 to 2021. The 2019 score is 58.33%.

- C. On the student survey: 65 % of the students will feel no repercussions involving the reporting of bullying.
- 4. Retention: Nemo Vista has a retention rate of 1% in grades 1st through 5th.
- 5. Transferring from an unsafe environment: Nemo Vista Elementary has a transferred rate of 0%.
- 6. Transferring in pursuant of School Choice: Nemo Vista Elementary has a transferred rate of 1.4%.

## Goals for 2019-2020 School Year:

- 1) To have every child in grades K-3 on reading grade level or have an action plan in place.
- 2) To address the weak areas of our curriculum based on STAR Reading, STAR Math and NWEA results during the 2021 school year.
- 3) To have an action plan for children who are considered at-risk.
- 4) To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.
- 5) To actively involve parents in their children's education/Title I Program/and IRI's.
- 6) Continue to align K-5 pacing guide to the Arkansas State Standards

through grade level and school wide PLCs.

- 7) To incorporate blended learning into the K-5 curriculum.
- 8) To provide virtual learning through the Buzz Platform.

Based on the ACT Aspire scores, we were above the National Average on all areas except Math.  $\,$ 

Based on the ESSA School Index report scores, we were above the state average in all areas except Caucasian students.
