Mission Statement: Every Child Every Chance

ESSA Report:

- Nemo Vista Middle School meets standards set by the Arkansas Department of Education.
- Due to Covid-19 there was not an ESSA report for the 2019-2020 school year.
- All of these statements are based on 2018-2019 because we did not have any data from the 2019-2020 school year due to Covid-19.
 - Nemo Vista Middle School received a Public School Rating of an “A” in 2019.
 - Literacy Scores: 60.72% of the students are achieving, which is down 5.21% from 2017. However, our students outscored the state of Arkansas by 13.47%.
 - Math Scores: 65.17% of the students are achieving, which is a 1.15% increase from 2017. Our students outscored the state by 15.81%.

Enrollment:

- Nemo Vista Middle School has 100 students.
- The student body has not grown this year but has remained steady.
- Has 12 virtual students which is down 15 from start of school year.

Comprehensive Assessment

- Renaissance Learning---A computerized assessment to assess early literacy skill, math skills, and literacy skills in grades K-12.
- NWEA MAP-A computerized assessment and intervention in literacy, math, and language use in grades 6-8.
- ACT Aspire---The ACT Aspire College and Career Readiness Solution a vertically-scaled assessment suite connected to The ACT®. This assessment will be given to grades 3rd-10th in Literacy, Math, and Science.

Goals from 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan:

- We were not able to determine if we achieved these goals due to the lack of data.

School Improvement Plan 2020-2021:

1. **Long Term Goal:** In 2020-2021 school year, students reading at, above, or within 6 months of grade level will increase by 5% compared to the 2018-2019 school year.
 - a. **Short Term Goal:** On the 2020-2021 STAR, 60% of the students will increase their reading level each semester.
2. **Long Term Goal:** Implement Canvas Learning Management System in the classroom, virtual, and blended learning.
 - a. **Short Term Goal:** Students will be able to access their learning while at school and at home.

3. **Long Term Goal:** In the 2020-2021 school year, the overall number of student to student discipline slips will be reduced by 10%.
 - a. **Short Term Goal:** A 10% decrease in student to student discipline slips to aid in the reduction of bullying compared to the 2018-2019 school year.

Goals for 2020-2021 School Year:

- 1) To address the weak areas of our curriculum and students based on ACT Aspire results 2018-2019, NWEA and STAR results from this year because we do not have the ACT Aspire results from the 2019-2020 school year to due to Covid-19.
- 2) Find ways to improve and increase student engagement for our virtual students.
- 3) To have an action plan for children who are considered at-risk.
- 4) To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.
- 5) To actively involve parents in their children's education.
- 5) To actively involve eighth grade in career and college readiness program.
- 6) To have Student Success Plans for all students in grades 6-8.
- 7) Continue to align 6th-8th grade pacing guides to the Arkansas State Standards.

Statements of Meeting Goals:

*Based on the ACT Aspire spring testing scores from the previous school year, we were above the state and national average in all subject areas, but due to Covid-19 and not ACT Aspire Testing in 2020, we do not know where we rank at this time in comparison to the state.
