Mission Statement: Success for tomorrow through education today.

ESSA Report:

- Nemo Vista High School meets standards set by the Arkansas Department of Education.
- Due to Covid-19 there was not an ESSA grade for the 2020-2021 school year; however, they did release a federal accountability score. High School scored 67.58% while the state's average score was 63.25 %.
- All of these statements are based on 2020-2021:
 - Literacy Scores: 36.20% of the students are achieving, which is a decrease of 21.62% from 2019. Our students outscored the state of Arkansas by an average of 3.05%.
 - Math Scores: 37.28% of the students are achieving, which is an increase of 2.35% from 2019. Our students outscored the state of Arkansas by an average of 14.50%.

Enrollment:

- Nemo Vista High School has 118 students.
- The student body is down 7 students from the year before.
- 16 students taking concurrent courses at UACCM currently
- 2 Virtual students which is down 12 from last year.

Comprehensive Assessment

- Renaissance Learning---A computerized assessment to assess early literacy skill, math skills and literacy skills in grades K-12.
- ACT Aspire---The ACT Aspire College and Career Readiness Solution a verticallyscaled assessment suite connected to The ACT®. This assessment will be given to grades 3rd-10th in Literacy, Math, and Science. The interims are given throughout the school year.
- ACT-American College Test-standardized test to determine a high school graduate's preparation for college-level work. It covers four areas: English, mathematics, reading, and science reasoning. It is given to all 11th graders one time but is available to be taken more than once and by other grades as well.

Goals from 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan:

• We were not able to meet our literacy and math goals from 2020-2021; therefore, we are going to continue working towards these goals.

School Improvement Plan:

1. **Long Term Goal:** In the 2021-2022 school year, students reading at, above, or within 6 months of grade level or scoring ready/exceeding will increase by 5% compared to the 2020-2021 school year.

- a. **Short Term Goal:** On the 2021-2022 STAR or interim assessments, 50% of the students will increase their reading score each semester.
- 2. Long Term Goal: In 2021-2022 school year, students scoring at, above, or within 6 months of grade level or scoring ready/exceeding in mathematics will increase 5% compared to the 2020-2021 school year.
 - a. **Short Term Goal**: On the 2021-2022 STAR or interim assessments, 50% of the students will increase their math reading score each semester.
- 3. Long Term Goal: In the 2021-2022 school year, the overall number of student discipline slips will be reduced by 5%.
 - a. **Short Term Goal:** A 5% decrease in student to student discipline slips to aid in the reduction of bullying.

Goals for 2020-2021 School Year:

- 1) To address the weak areas of our curriculum and students based on results from the ACT Aspire and STAR.
- 2) To have an action plan for children who are considered at-risk.
- 3) To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.
- 4) To actively involve parents in their children's education.
- 5) To actively involve grades 9-12 in career and college readiness programs.
- 6) To have Student Success Plans for all students in grades 9-12.
- Continue to align 9th-12th grade pacing guides to the Arkansas State Standards.

Statements of Meeting Goals:

**Based on the ACT Aspire spring testing scores, we were above the state average in all subject areas except 9th grade English, Reading, and Science.
