Mission Statement: Maximize student learning to be productive citizens in an ever-changing world.

ESSA Report:

- Nemo Vista High School meets standards set by the Arkansas Department of Education.
- The ESSA grade for the 2021-2022 school year High School scored 75.4% while the state's average score was 64.02%.
- The school value added growth was 81.88% which is up from 2019 at 80.22% for NVHS. The state average was at 79.86%.
- All of these statements are based on 2021-2022:
 - Literacy Scores Ready or Exceeding: 59.62% (9-10) of the students are achieving. Our students outscored the state of Arkansas(40.03%) by 19.59%.
 - Math Scores Ready or Exceeding: 44.23% (9-10) of the students are achieving. Our students outscored the state of Arkansas(38.52%) by 5.71%.

Enrollment:

- Nemo Vista High School currently has 136 students.
- The student body has increased by 18 from last year at this time. This is in part due to a big ninth grade class that moved up from 8th grade last year.

Comprehensive Assessment

- Renaissance Learning---A computerized assessment to assess early literacy skill, math skills, and literacy skills in grades K-12.
- ACT Aspire---The ACT Aspire College and Career Readiness Solution a vertically-scaled assessment suite connected to The ACT®. This assessment will be given to grades 3rd-10th in Literacy, Math, and Science.
- ACT-grades 9-12; with a provided test for Juniors each Spring

Goals from 2020-2021 School Improvement Plan:

- We are continuing to work towards improving our literacy scores this school year.

School Improvement Plan 2022-2023:

1. **Long Term Goal:** In the 2022-2023 school year, students reading at, above, or within 6 months of grade level or scoring ready/exceeding will increase by 5% compared to the 2021-2022 school year.

a. **Short Term Goal:** On the 2022-2023 STAR or interim assessments, 50% of the students will increase their reading score each semester.

2. **Long Term Goal:** In 2022-2023 school year, students scoring at, above, or within 6 months of grade level or scoring ready/exceeding in mathematics will increase 5% compared to the 2021-2022 school year.

a. **Short Term Goal:** On the 2022-2023 STAR or interim assessments, 50% of the students will increase their math reading score each semester.

3. **Long Term Goal:** In the 2022-2023 school year, 60% of the 9th grade class will complete their Computer Science requirement for graduation.

a. **Short Term Goal:** In the 2022-2023 school year, the students will receive at least ½ of the full credit via face-to-face.

Goals for 2022-2023 School Year:

- 1) To address the weak areas of our curriculum and students based on ACT Aspire, ACT, Grades/Credits, and STAR results.
- 2) To have an action plan for students who are considered at-risk. (Ex: RTI period, Credit Recovery).
- 3) To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.
- 4) To actively involve parents in their children's education. (Ex: Family Mental Healthcare night in October, senior FAFSA night)
- 5) To actively involve eighth grade in a career and college readiness program. (Ex: School Counts speaker; counselor with GUIDE for life training)
- 6) To make sure seniors have all credits and apply for scholarships to further their education.
- 7) To assist graduates this year with resumes and cover letters for jobs and visiting trade expos.
- 8) Continue to align 9th-12th grade pacing guides to the Arkansas State Standards.

Statements of Meeting Goals:

*Based on the ACT Aspire spring testing scores, we were above the state average in all subject areas as a whole.
