ESSA Report:

- Nemo Vista Elementary School meets standards set by the Arkansas Department of Education.
- ESSA grade for the 2021-2022 school year: Letter Grade C with a score of 69.46%. (Increase from 68.82% last year.) The state's average score was 67.28%.
- All of these statements are based on 2021-2022:
 - Literacy Scores: 44% of the students are achieving. Our students outscored the state of Arkansas by an average of 6%.
 - Math Scores: 60% of the students are achieving. Our students outscored the state of Arkansas by an average of 13%.

Enrollment:

- Nemo Vista Elementary School currently has 255 students.
- The student body has grown this year by over 13 students.

Comprehensive Assessment

- Renaissance Learning---A computerized assessment to assess early literacy skills, math skills, and literacy skills in grades K-12.
- NWEA MAP-A computerized assessment and intervention in literacy, math, and language use in grades K-8.
- ACT Aspire---The ACT Aspire College and Career Readiness Solution a vertically-scaled assessment suite connected to The ACT®. This assessment will be given to grades 3rd-10th in Literacy, Math, and Science.

Goals from 2021-2022 School Improvement Plan:

- We were not able to meet our literacy goal from the 2021-2022 school year; therefore, we are continuing to work towards it this school year.

School Improvement Plan 2022-2023:

1. **Long Term Goal:** On the 2023 SQSS: Reading at Grade Level Score will increase by 5% compared to the 2022 SQSS.
 - a. **Short Term Goal:** On the STAR Assessment, 80% of the students will increase their reading level each Semester from the spring 2022 to the spring of 2023.
2. **Long Term Goal:** On the 2023 SQSS: Student Engagement Score will increase by 5% compared to the 2022 SQSS.

- a. **Short Term Goal:** 65% of the students will maintain 3 or less absences quarterly. Data collected showed that many days were missed by students in grades K-5. This data is distorted due to quarantines from Covid.
3. **Long Term Goal:** 75% of the students scoring below the 50%tile on the Map Testing in math will show growth through every testing period.
 - a. **Short Term Goal:** 75% of the students designated as scoring below the 50%tile on the Map testing will show improvement on the STAR Math given quarterly.

Goals for 2022-2023 School Year:

- 1) To address the weak areas of our curriculum and students based on ACT Aspire, NWEA MAP, and STAR results.
- 2) To have an action plan for children who are considered at-risk.
- 3) To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.
- 4) To actively involve parents in their children's education.
- 5) Continue to align K-5th grade pacing guides to the Arkansas State Standards.

Statements of Meeting Goals:

*Based on the ACT Aspire spring testing scores, we were above the state average in all subject areas as a whole; however, we were not above the state in 5th grade ELA and tied the state in ELA in grades 3rd and 4th.
