ESSA Report:

- Nemo Vista Elementary School meets standards set by the Arkansas Department of Education.
- ESSA grade for the 2022-2023 school year: Letter Grade C with a score of 71.43%. (Increase from 69.46% last year.) The state's average score was 67.62%.
- All of these statements are based on 2022-2023:
 - Weighted Achievement: 66.26% outscored the state of Arkansas by almost 10% and improved from last year over 3.5%.
 - Value Added Growth: 79.03%: we were outscored by the state of Arkansas by less than 2% and improved our growth from last year by 1.5%.
 - School Quality and Student Success: 58.15: we outscored the state over 8%.

Enrollment:

- Nemo Vista Elementary School currently has 229 students.
- The student body has declined this year by 26 students.

Comprehensive Assessment

- Renaissance Learning---A computerized assessment to assess early literacy skills, math skills, and literacy skills in grades K-12.
- NWEA MAP-A computerized assessment and intervention in literacy, math, and language use in grades K-8.
- ATLAS---Arkansas Teaching and Learning Assessment System. This assessment will be given to grades 3rd-10th in ELA, Math, and Science.

Goals from 2022-2023 School Improvement Plan:

• We were able to meet our goals from the 2022-2023 school year; however, we feel the need to continue to work towards improving on these goals each school year.

School Improvement Plan 2023-2024:

1. **Long Term Goal:** On the 2024 SQSS: Reading at Grade Level Score will increase by 5% compared to the 2023 SQSS.

Short Term Goal: On the STAR Assessment, 80% of the students will increase their reading level each assessment.

2. **Long Term Goal:** On the 2024 SQSS: Student engagement will increase by 5% compared to the 2023 SQSS.

Short Term Goal: 65% of the students will maintain 3 or less absences quarterly. Data collected showed that many days were missed by students in grades K-5.

3. **Long Term Goal:** On the ESSA School Index, Value Added Growth, will increase 5% compared to 2023.

Short Term Goal: 75% of the students designated as scoring below the 50% tile on the Map testing will show improvement from the fall of 2023 to the winter of 2024.

4. **Long Term Goal:** 75% of the 3rd grade will be reading at or above grade level by the end of 3rd grade.

Short Term Goal: 80% of the students reading below grade level at the beginning of 3rd grade will increase their reading level each STAR assessment.

Goals for 2023-2024 School Year:

- 1) To address the weak areas of our curriculum and students based on ACT Aspire, NWEA MAP, and STAR results.
- 2) To have an action plan for children who are considered at-risk.
- 3) To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.
- 4) To actively involve parents in their children's education.
- 5) Continue to align K-5th grade pacing guides to the Arkansas State Standards.

Statements of Meeting Goals:

*Based on the ACT Aspire spring testing scores, we were above the state average in all subject areas as a whole; however, we were not above the state in 4th grade ELA and 4th and 5th grade Science.
