Mission Statement: Maximize student learning to be productive citizens in an ever-changing world.

Enrollment:

- Nemo Vista High School currently has 131 students.
 - 9th Grade-30
 - 10th Grade-36
 - 11th Grade-31
 - 12th Grade-34
- total=131 HS students

Comprehensive Assessment

- IXL Diagnostics: Math, Science, & Literacy for grade level RTI
- ATLAS Classroom Tool
- **ATLAS**---The ATLAS assessment is a state assessment aligning with state standards to give schools an insight into student progress. This assessment will be given to grades 3-10th in Literacy, Math, and Science. End of Course Testing for Algebra I, Geometry, English 9th Grade, English 10th Grade, and Biology
- ASVAB: Assessment for career and skills that they can align in the military and outside of the military.
- Accuplacer: Assessment to enroll in UACCM or equivalent concurrent programs.
- ACT-grades 9-12; with a provided test for Juniors each Spring
- ACT WorkKeys: Career-Development and Technical skills assessment to earn ranked certificates of skills.
- PSAT: 10th graders will take the Prep SAT focusing on testing skills needed for the SAT

Goals Met from 2024-2025 School Improvement Plan:

- In the 2024-2025 school year, the number of students in the 9th-12th grade enrolled in a certificate CTE, concurrent, or college prep program will be over 50% this goal was met.
- In the 2024-2025 school year Nemo Vista HS will continue to promote and push for 90% of the combined number of students in 10th, 11th, & 12th to take some form of readiness in either the fall or spring of the School Year, this goal was met.

School Improvement Plan 2025-2026:

1. **Long-Term Goal:** In the 2025-2026 school year, the number of students scoring within grade level or at the level of proficient/exceeding in ELA (9th-10th), Algebra I, Geometry, and Biology on the ATLAS state End of Course exams will be at or over 65%.
 - a. **Short-Term Goal:** On the 2025-2026 ATLAS interim assessments, those students not proficient/exceeding will work on RTI to improve scores each assessment.
2. **Long-Term Goal:** In the 2025-2026 school year, the number of students in the 9th-12th grade enrolled in a certificate CTE, concurrent, or college prep program will be over 50%.
 - a. **Short-Term Goal:** In 2025-2026, all 9th-12th grade students will be on a career or college HS diploma route with a SMART objective tied to their Success Plan.
3. **Long-Term Goal:** In the 2025-2026 school year, Nemo Vista HS will continue to promote and push for 95% of the combined number of students in 10th, 11th, & 12th to take some form of readiness in either the fall or spring of the School Year.
 - a. **Short-Term Goal:** In 2025-2026, 95% of the combined number of students in the Sophomore, Junior, and Senior classes will have taken the Accuplacer, ACT Workkeys Readiness Assessment, or ACT.
4. **Long-Term Goal:** In the 2025-2026 school year, the school will continue to promote and push for students to take more AP, concurrent, CTE H2 pathways, or skills or college prep programs leading to diplomas with Merit or Distinction.
 - a. **Short-Term Goal:** In the 2025-2026 school year, at least 50% of students will be on a pathway to a diploma with Merit or Distinction.

Goals for 2025-2026 School Year:

- 1) To continue to address the weak areas of our curriculum and students based on ATLAS Growth & Achievement, Success Ready Pathways & Credits, Community Service Hours, and ATLAS results.
- 2) To continue to improve and work on Tier II interventions for students that demonstrated a limited understanding of grade level content. (Ex: RTI period, Credit Recovery, Alternate Pathways).
- 3) To identify homeless children and service their needs according to the McKinney-Vento Act.
- 4) To actively involve teachers & parents in the students' education. (Ex: Career Coach setting up Career tours/visiting expos; Arkansas College Application October; Concurrent enrollment)
- 5) To make sure students have a success plan, have chosen a career or collegiate pathway, and that all seniors have all their credits and apply for scholarships to further their education.

6) To assist graduates this year with resumes and cover letters for jobs and visiting trade expos (Career Expo-September in Clinton, March on NV site, & April at MHS). (Ex: Resume Workshop-October[seniors] & Mock Interviews-November)

7) Continue to align 9th-12th grade pacing guides to the Arkansas State Standards and the use of HQIM (Ex: BSCS/IM/VA content/DCTE Pathways)

8) To gain knowledgeable insight from the ATLAS sources available to help students and teachers focus on building mastery of skills and standards. (EX: ATLAS training, ATLAS Livebinder, ATLAS Blueprints, etc.)
