Nemo Vista High School SMART Goals

1. **Long Term Goal:** In the 2022-2023 school year, students reading at, above, or within 6 months of grade level or scoring ready/exceeding will increase by 5% compared to the 2021-2022 school year.
 - a. **Short Term Goal:** On the 2022-2023 STAR or interim assessments, 50% of the students will increase their reading score each semester.
2. **Long Term Goal:** In 2022-2023 school year, students scoring at, above, or within 6 months of grade level or scoring ready/exceeding in mathematics will increase 5% compared to the 2021-2022 school year.

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- a. **Short Term Goal:** On the 2022-2023 STAR or interim assessments, 50% of the students will increase their math reading score each semester.

- 3. **Long Term Goal:** In the 2022-2023 school year, 60% of the 9th grade class will complete their Computer Science requirement for graduation.
 - a. **Short Term Goal:** In the 2022-2023 school year, the students will receive at least ½ of the full credit via face-to-face.
