For the next two weeks our class will study the genre of narrative nonfiction. We will be focusing on how people from different cultures contribute to a community. We will be discussing how we can learn from people from another culture.

Here are some resources that you can use with your child to help reinforce the skills we'll be practicing.

Word Workout

- Vocabulary Discuss the meanings of the vocabulary words with your child.
 Then you and your child will play a sentence activity.
- High Frequency Words: Help your child think of an invention that has changed your family's life. Then work with your child to use the list words to tell about that invention.

Spelling Words

- Week 1: Words with short vowels a, i Read the words to your child. Have your child raise one or two hands to show what sound he or she hears in a word.
- Week 2: Words with short vowels e, o, u Your child is going to name the letter that stands for the vowel he or she hears when you read a word from the list. Then your child will spell the word.
